Recipients-

You are receiving this email relative to your role as a contractor, developer, consultant or other entity associated with stormwater permitting in Stafford County.

Stafford County is accepting renewal submittals for the 2019-2024 Construction General Permit (CGP). This office will be collecting renewals and entering the information in the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality's (VDEQ) Stormwater Construction General Permit System when that system is operational.

DO NOT SUBMIT RENEWALS AS EMAIL ATTACHMENTS. The preferred methods of submittal are via an FTP virtual document, 'Dropbox', or similar method linked in an email or conventional mail. Renewals provided as **email attachments will not be accepted** due to the large volume of anticipated emails / attachments and recipient's limited email storage. There is not a renewal fee.

Submittals should-

- Be consistent with the information of the current permit.
- Satisfy renewal registration statement Section II.A.- the approved site plan 'overall' sheet may adequately show a) the location of the existing land disturbing activity, b) limits of land disturbance, c) construction entrances, and d) all water bodies receiving stormwater discharges from the site.
- Provide appropriate location information in decimal degrees.
- Include total area of land development, estimated area to be disturbed, and any offsite area to be disturbed (where applicable).
- Include other information as appears on the renewal application.
- Renewals are dependent upon up-to-date grading and stormwater permit maintenance fees, contact the Stafford County Community Development (renewals without appropriate annual maintenance fees may not be eligible for renewal).

The VDEQ statement and permit have specific signatory requirements specified in Section VI, please have the appropriate signatory entity sign the form.

Submittals are preferred to be scanned; the combined signed renewal statement and supporting paperwork are preferred **attached to an on-line file sharing site.** Email the link to [srae@staffordcountyva.gov](mailto:srae@staffordcountyva.gov). Applications may also be mailed Stafford County Public Works [Environmental Programs], P. O. Box 339, Stafford, VA 22555.

Please visit the [Stafford County Environmental webpage](#), access the [VSMP CGP link](#) on the left margin, and review the documents associated with the CGP. Refer to the [VDEQ's VAR10 Fact Sheet](#) for questions on 'under construction' criteria relative to projects' Part IIB/C eligibility, Appendices A and B are provided for clarification. Permittees concerned about Part IIB/C qualification may schedule an appointment with this office by calling (540) 658-8667.

An auto-generated letter will be provided to permittees following entry and subsequent approval by VDEQ staff.

Submittals pre-dating this letter should consider resubmitting for reassurance of receipt and completeness of submittal with supporting documentation.

Projects qualifying for termination should complete the Notice of Termination available on the [VDEQ CGP website](#).
