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# Route 610 and Onville Road



# What will the project do?

- Support additional traffic generated by jobs located at Quantico Marine Corps Base
- Widen intersection to build new turn lanes
- Reduce delay for motorists



# Route 610 eastbound

## *Existing condition:*

- 1 left turn lane
- 2 through lanes
- 1 shared through/  
right turn lane

## *After construction:*

- 2 left turn lanes
- 3 through lanes
- West of Onville Road, medians on Route 610 will be built to separate eastbound and westbound traffic



# Route 610 westbound

## *Existing condition:*

- 1 right turn lane
- 2 through lanes
- 1 left turn lane

## *After construction:*

- 1 right turn lane
- 3 through lanes
- 1 left turn lane



# Onville Road

## *Existing condition:*

- 1 left turn lane
- 1 shared through, right turn lane

## *After construction:*

- 2 left turn lanes
- 1 shared left turn and through lane
- 1 right turn lane



# Fast Facts: Construction

- Construction began in December 2015
- Project contractor is J.L. Kent and Sons, Inc., of Fredericksburg
- 18 months of construction
- Completion in May 2017
- Work zones will be coordinated with Route 610 widening



## Project Cost

Preliminary Engineering: \$1.3 million  
 Right of Way: \$8 million  
 Construction: \$5.5 million

**TOTAL**  
**\$14.9 million**

# How will construction affect me?

## Lane closures

- Most will occur at night and off-peak travel times

### Route 610 eastbound

8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

### Route 610 westbound

9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

### Onville Road

7 p.m. to 6 a.m.



# How will construction affect me?

## Temporary traffic patterns

- Onville Road is reduced to one lane in each direction until May 2017

## Pardon our dust

- Equipment

- Temporary driving surface may be rougher
- New pavement surface added at end of project
